Mission oriented approaches need to....

1. ...include possible unintended consequences of “Missions for Sustainability” into our planning processes today. ...include participatory knowledge and policies of the commons.
2. An important mission for mission-oriented approaches for RTI is to decolonize the past and provincialize the present:

(decolonizing the past means to avoid measuring understandings or RTI of past societies on a modern understanding RTI as a western, secularized, rational project; Provincializing the present means especially to provincialize the global north and include what mission oriented-approaches for RTI means from a Global South perspective)
